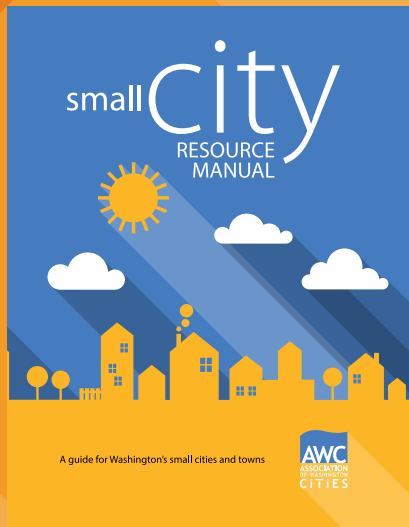


A proclamation honoring Craig George



Proclamation

A PROCLAMATION of the Association of Washington Cities (AWC), AWC Employee Benefit Trust, and AWC Risk Management Service Agency expressing our sincerest appreciation of Craig George for his dedication, enthusiasm, and passion in support of Washington's 281 cities and towns.

WHEREAS, Craig George served the residents of the City of Dayton as Mayor and was a tenacious advocate to improve the city with better streets, a beautiful and vibrant main street, enhanced economic development, and so much more.

WHEREAS, Craig George was an enthusiastic representative of Washington's more than 160 small cities as a member of the AWC Small City Advisory Committee from 2008 until 2018, as Co-Chair from January 2010 to June 2012, and as a frequent and devoted attendee at AWC's Small City Roundups and then later at the Small City Connectors.

WHEREAS, Craig George was a diligent and dedicated member of the AWC Board of Directors from January 2010 until June 2016, where he served as Secretary from 2011 to 2012, Vice President from 2012 to 2013, President from 2013 to 2014, Immediate Past President from 2014 to 2015, and Past President from June 2015 to December 2015, and back to Immediate Past President from January 2016 to June 2016.

WHEREAS, Craig George unselfishly served on the AWC Employee Benefit Trust Board of Trustees from July 2012 to June 2014, where he was a steadfast voice for the more than 270 Trust member employers and 36,000 insured lives.

WHEREAS, Craig George passionately served the 100 members of the AWC Risk Management Service Agency (RMSA) from November 2014 to November 2018, where he served as Vice President from March 2018 until his resignation in November 2018, and actively spread the word that RMSA was the best risk pool option for Washington's cities and towns.




