

## Why We Are Here

- In 2013, the International City/County Management Association (ICMA) convened a Women in the Profession Task Force.
  - Only 13% of city manager/ administrator positions were filled by women (same as in 1981—32 years later).
- In 2018, Washington City/County Management Association (WCMA) launches NW Women's Leadership Academy.
- In 2024, NWWLA is now on our 6<sup>th</sup> Cohort; approximately 168 women have graduated, and we'll hit 200+ in March!

## NWWLA Vision & Mission


### **Vision**
