Naval Academy, Fred Brink served on active duty as a U.S. Navy surface warfare officer for six years prior to his appointment as a special agent of the Federal Bureau of Investigation. His 25-year FBI career included investigative assignments in several field offices, FBI Headquarters, an overseas assignment as the FBI's Legal Attache to the U.S. Embassy in Riyadh, Saudi Arabia, and a field command assignment as the Special Agent in Charge for the State of Mississippi. After retiring from the FBI in 2009, Fred managed the Pacific Northwest National Laboratory's counterintelligence program for 10 years.
